## ***Determinate Tomatoes:***

Determinate tomatoes grow to a set size and produce most of their fruit over a shorter period. They stay more compact, making them a great choice for small spaces and containers. These plants are easier to manage and typically require less pruning and support.

## ***Indeterminate Tomatoes:***

Indeterminate tomatoes continue growing and producing fruit all season long. These varieties can get large and need strong support, regular pruning, and more space. While they require more effort, they reward you with ongoing harvests.

### **5 Gallon Container**

**Best for: Cherry & Dwarf Tomatoes**

**Examples: *Tiny Tim, Sungold, Red Robin***

### **7–10 Gallon Container**

**Best for: Determinate Tomatoes**

**Examples: *Roma, Celebrity, Bush Early Girl***

### **10–15+ Gallon Container**

**Best for: Large / Indeterminate Tomatoes**

**Examples: *Beefsteak, Brandywine, Better Boy***
